Employee Spotlight: Jacci Ottosen

WaterPro's rates for our pressure irrigation (PI) system will increase by 5% beginning January 1, 2022. This rate change is in response to our increasing costs and our need to plan for future needs to keep your water system in the best possible shape. As a customer-owned cooperative, we strive to keep our costs and rates as low as we can while also providing the best service.

The chart below shows how this rate change will be applied. Since virtually all our PI customers now have meters on their service, you can monitor your own usage and plan to conserve if necessary to reduce your costs for irrigation water.

If your property was recently metered, you will continue to be billed under the previous flat-rate system until the end of 2022.

For the next year, your PI bill will show the flat rate that you will continue to pay, along with the actual amount of water you used and the amount you *would have paid* if you were being billed by metered use. This will give you a chance to monitor your usage through the seasons and plan any adjustments you would like to make.

By January 2023, all our metered customers will be paying the metered rate rather than the flat rate. If you have any questions, please contact us to learn more.
